

DETENTION GUIDELINES FOR TEACHERS:

1. All assignments are due at the beginning of the class period.
2. When an assignment is given, students must hang on to it until the day and class period it is due. This is part of being responsible -- hanging on to it and knowing where it is.
3. Students may go back to their rooms AFTER class to get a COMPLETED assignment if they forgot it in the room. (try not to make this a habit)
4. Students may not call home to have mom and dad bring the assignment in. (in fairness for students whose parents work or live in the country -- so parents aren't being the ones punished)
5. If an assignment is done, but at home, it is still a detention.
6. Paper work items:
 - a. Students will serve their detention in Mrs. Kuiper's room. Students will diligently write appropriate lines in cursive during the entire IM detention period.
 - b. Students will need to take home their detention slip and return it with a parent signature the next school day.
 - c. On a third detention within a month, students are warned (via a note on the parental slip) the 4th and any subsequent detentions will be thirty minute after-school detentions with the homeroom teacher supervising.
