WHAT'S HAPPENING IN OUR ROOM?

- . **Show and Tell** - The students' names under the days of the week, are the ones who have show and tell on that day. When we don't have school on your child's day due to vacation, etc. they may bring it on a day of their choice. This week we will practice good show and tell manners and I will have them share various things about themselves.
- . **Labels for learning** - We have a box in our classroom that we would love to get filled many times during the school year. Bring all labels, pizza ranch corners, milk lids etc. to school and we'll see how fast we can fill our box!

Reading: Most Mondays a paper called **Family Times** will come home. It will let you know what skills we are learning for the week and suggest activities you can do at home to reinforce what is being learned at school. You may not have time to do everything during the week, but if you choose at least one or two things, that will be great as well. This week, it will not be coming home because we will be doing some kindergarten review and some assessing. We will also be making several class books that we will enjoy reading throughout the year.

Math: We begin the year with a review of kindergarten skills for the first week, will do an activity with ten black dots, and then have some surprise activities on Friday 😊.

Spelling: Most weeks we will have anywhere from 6-12 words to learn for spelling. The words will be associated with our reading series. Weeks when we have less than five days we may not have a list or we will have a shorter list. This week we won't have one yet.

Writing/Penmanship: Our writing this week will focus on writing our names, reviewing some of our letters, and writing about what we learned already!

Bible: It is such a joy to be able to already at this age learn so much about not only God but also how He desires we live for Him. Each week we will have a passage to memorize. At times we may have the same passage for two or three weeks depending on the length and/or difficulty.

Social Studies/Science: This week and next we will talk about how our school is a community and what that means. We will review the importance of school rules, working together, etc.
