Tiger PAWS Mission and Vision

The mission of Tiger PAWS (Parents and Advocates Willing to Serve) is to build the OCCS community through prayer, service and financial support.

Tiger PAWS vision is to provide prayer, service opportunities, and financial support for our school because of our commitment to Christian education.

What are my Tiger PAWS responsibilities?

- 1. September **OCCS Society Meeting** attend to hear Tiger PAWS update and financials. Any vote (if needed) would take place at this meeting.(optional)
- 2. September / October Fall Frozen Pigs fundraiser. All members help make pigs on one of two designated nights.
- 3. February **Soup Supper** some families work at the soup supper or make soup or tavern in their home for the soup supper
- 4. April All families help make **Pig-in-the-blankets** for Tulip Festival on one of two designated nights.
- 5. May **Tulip Festival** All families sign up to work a shift via the signup.com link sent out by the committee.
- 6. **Additional responsibilities:** Watch for a sign up link via the signup.com to sign up for one of the following work groups:
 - Soup Supper: Make soup or tavern in your home
 - Soup Supper: Work at the soup supper
 - Tulip Festival Soup/Tavern: Make soup/tavern as a group at school
 - **Tulip Festival:** Help set up the tent
 - Tulip Festival: Help tear down the tent

A Glimpse of Each Tiger PAWS Event

All Tiger PAWS events have volunteer chairpersons. The work groups referred throughout are put together by the Tiger PAWS Board. Look for more information regarding these events as they take place in the weekly email Tiger PAWS update.

Fall Frozen Pigs

Selling frozen pig-in-the-blankets in the fall became a reality in 2020! It has been a wonderful success each fall. Families and Individuals look forward to filling their freezer in preparation for winter. PAWS plans to do that again this fall. All families participate in making pigs.

Soup Supper

The annual Tiger PAWS Soup Supper is held in late January or early February. This event is an opportunity to enjoy food and fellowship with friends, family, neighbors and the community. The

meal consists of several kinds of soup, hot dogs, tavern, pies, and desserts. Recipes for soup and tavern are provided.

Pig-in-the-Blankets

In the spring, Tiger PAWS members are asked to make thousands of pig-in-the-blankets. These are used for the two Tulip Festival stands. This is a unique item that draws many people to our Festival stands. All Tiger PAWS members participate in one of the two nights of making pig-in-the-blankets.

Tulip Festival

The Tiger PAWS tent at the Tulip Festival is the biggest fundraiser for Tiger PAWS and takes the full cooperation from each member. The tent is located in the Iowa State Bank parking lot. Each family works a shift of a few hours some time during the Festival (either parent can take this shift or you can hire someone to work your shift). Some of the jobs available are cashier, serving, dishwashing, cutting pies, serving drinks, and waitressing.

Year Round Tiger PAWS Projects

Apparel/Promotional Sales

The Apparel/Promotional Sales committee develops apparel to help promote OCCS in the community as well as generate pride and support for our school and its students. Watch the weekly school emails for a link to the online store. The Apparel Store is open seasonally and apparel will be available for pick-up at the school when ready.

Grade Level Coordinators (GLC)

The GLC Committee will organize a grade level coordinator (GLC) for each classroom at fall registration. A GLC will offer assistance to the teacher through planning classroom parties, lining up gifts for the teacher, lining up volunteers for various classroom events, etc. Being a GLC is a great way to partner with your child's teacher.
